This past summer I had an opportunity to meet Jim Wyer, a lifetime resident of Deephaven, at his home in the Glen Lake area of Minnetonka. I tagged along on an appointment with Melinda Nelson who is writing a book on the boathouses of Lake Minnetonka.

Jim's parents settled on Robinson's Bay around 1912 and when his parents passed away, Jim purchased their home and lived there until 1960 and then built a home on Northome overlooking Bay St. Louis in Deephaven and lived there until 2000. He is now 96 years old is still very sharp and has an amazing memory on Lake Minnetonka history. As with most people, Jim did not appreciate history as a young man but once he got older he learned to appreciate it and started collecting pictures of Lake Minnetonka. After years of collecting pictures, his collection grew to over 600 photos. I had the opportunity of going through his collection which is kept at the Western Hennepin County Pioneer Museum and they were kind enough to let me use a few for our newsletter.
